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Community Health

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WHO: ICCF was created in 2016 to provide primary care for uninsured working adults in Northern Virginia. Services were expanded to include children and Medicaid enrollees following Virginia's Medicaid Expansion in 2020.

WHAT: ICCF provides comprehensive primary care services to patients who reflect the culturally diverse community we serve. Caring for patients of all ages who qualify for Medicaid or are uninsured by enrolling them in Inova's Financial Assistance Program.

WHERE: The Inova Cares Clinics for Families has 6 locations:

- Alexandria
- Annandale
- Manassas
- Sterling
- Fairfax (*Opening Soon*)
- Herndon (*Opening Soon*)

WHY: Serving the under-resourced members of the communities, in their communities, by caring for their complex medical, social, and behavioral needs.

HOW: Various Team Members who provide care and service to patients and community members as follows:

Accessing our Services: On-site Team Members who help patients and community members:

- Determine if qualify for Medicaid and help apply apply/enroll
- If don't qualify, assist them with applying to Inova's Financial Assistance Program (FAP)

Provide Care and Services within Clinic:

- Physicians (Internal Meds / Family Medicine / Pediatrics)
- Advanced Practice Providers (NPs/Pas)
- Nurse Care Coordinators
- Social Worker Case Managers

Provide Services in the Community

- Community Health/Outreach Workers
